Hope that you have had a lovely summer break!

We are very much looking forward to welcoming you and your fellow students back to school this term. Starting school again on campus, it is important that we try our best to limit the spread of infection and take care of each other.

One way infection spreads is over-crowding on public transport. After discussions with Västtrafik we ask you, if possible, to avoid public transport to and from school, to lessen the risk of over-crowding for those who have no other means of transport. Please use your bike, walk or car-pool. Avoid catching the bus on the last stretch before school.

As of right now the school administration has not decided to offer modified school hours or distance courses.

However, if the administration finds this necessary, due to the risk of infection spreading (either within or outside of school) school hours may be modified or courses offered as distance learning. This will be considered and assessed on a weekly basis.

We have adapted furniture in school to create space between desks and, in a few classrooms we have only kept the chairs to guarantee adequate spacing between students.

Hand sanitizers will be available to everyone and markings on the floor will help with distancing in the canteen and school café.

We will not gather large groups of students in the theatre and will display the Swedish Public Health Agency's advice as a reminder to us all.

We must all take responsibility by:

- Staying at home if you experience symptoms of a cold
- Washing your hands often with soap and water and for at least 20 seconds
- Keeping at arm's length from others
- Coughing and sneezing into your elbow
- Considering how you greet friends, avoid hugs
- Teachers will ask students who display symptoms of a cold to leave school
